Hello, and Happy Spring/Summer! I hope this letter finds you winding down from the school year and planning what to do once school is out. My name is Mr. Derek Smilowski & together with Mr. David Carlsen; we are the directors of the Eastern Hills High School Band. We would like to take a moment to talk about what an awesome year we have had with your kids as well as provide some information for new and returning members.

This past year the band has improved in leaps & bounds! At Marching UIL, we received a rating of 1-2-2, at Solo & Ensemble UIL, we had 8 students make a 1st division, & at Concert & Sight Reading UIL, we received a 1-2-2 on stage and a 1-1-1 in Sight Reading! This is the first time the EHHS band program has received a prestigious award in more than 10 years. As many of you are aware, our musicians work very hard, and these results come from all of our dedication to this program and the belief that music can inspire & change lives.

Now to the nitty gritty; we know summer is a time to relax and unwind, but we still have some band housekeeping things to take care of. Graduation is Friday 5/31/19 - then the following day, Saturday 6/1/19, is registration day for all new and returning members.
